Describe your group/organisation

Health for All Community Group is a grassroots organisation based in London that focuses on increasing health awareness and improving access to healthcare resources within underrepresented communities. We work primarily with Black and ethnic minority groups, providing educational workshops, health screenings, and supporting people in accessing health services.

Some of our key achievements include:

- Organising over 50 health workshops in the past year, reaching 1,200 individuals from underserved communities.

How does your work relate to the biomedical research field?

How do you plan to use this funding?

We plan to use the £5,000 funding to enhance and expand our services in the following ways:

1. Staff Payment (Total: £2,000)

• We will allocate £2,000 to cover the payment of part-time staff who will facilitate our health workshops and outreach programs. This will help us reach more people in the community and provide them with crucial health resources.

2. Organising Health Awareness Events (Total: £1,500)

• £1,500 will be used to cover the costs of renting venues and purchasing materials for health awareness events and workshops. This will ensure that our events are accessible to a larger number of participants and provide essential health information.

3. Training and Development (Total: £500)

• £500 will be allocated towards training volunteers on how to deliver health education workshops and navigate the complexities of biomedical research and healthcare access. This will ensure our staff and volunteers are well-equipped to offer the best possible support to our community.

4. Digital Infrastructure (Total: £1,000)

 We will invest £1,000 in digital tools and software, such as a Zoom subscription for online workshops and a CRM system for tracking community health data. This will allow us to continue engaging with our community virtually and maintain better records of our outreach activities and participants.
